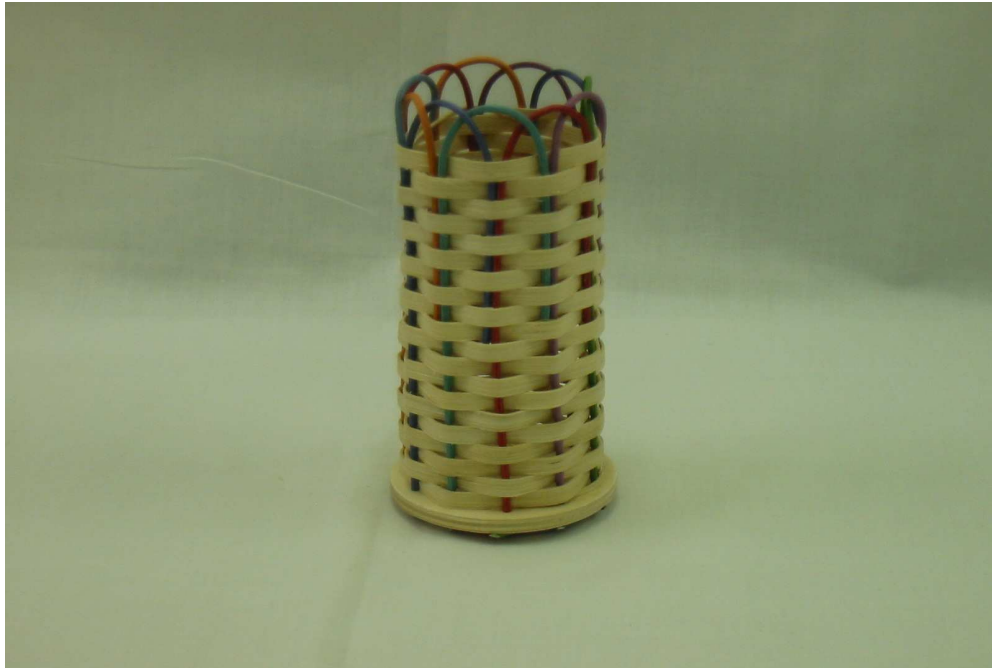

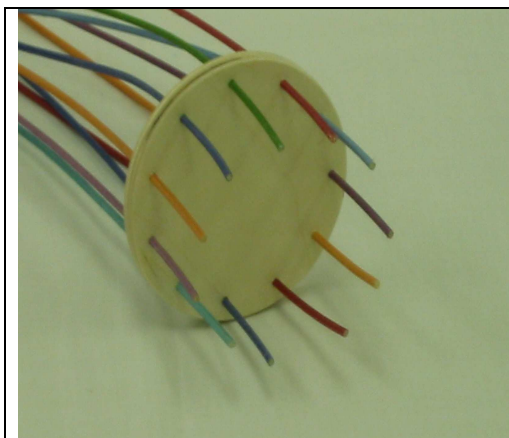


Dimensions: 3" Diameter, 6" Tall

Materials List

3" Round Drilled Base, 11 holes
#3 Dyed Round Reed, 11 @ 13"

¼" flat weavers, 18'







Soak spokes.

Wipe spokes through towel to remove excess dye.

Insert damp spokes through base for about 2".

	<p>Take a spoke end behind the spoke to its left and out to lean on the spoke two to its left. Continue this around the base. Tuck the last spoke end into its right place.</p>
	<p>Taper a soaked weaver for about 3" to a point. Tuck the point behind a spoke. Begin weaving over/under the spokes.</p>
	<p>Weave about 16-20 rows up the basket. Be careful to keep walls going straight up. When a weaver runs out, add a new one with a 4 spoke overlap. Taper weaver to a point to end.</p>
	<p>Soak tops of spokes. Bend a spoke over and tuck it in next to the spoke 2 places to its right. Continue around basket.</p> <p>Sign and date your basket. Enjoy!</p>
